

RE: Sponsorship Letter of Intent for the 20th International GC×GC Symposium

Dear Sponsor,

Thank you for your interest in supporting the 20th International GC×GC Symposium to be held at the Coast Canmore Hotel and Conference Centre in Canmore, Alberta, Canada from May 28th to June 1st, 2023. This year's meeting is being planned as an in-person event. As our first in-person meeting since 2019, and the 20th edition of this meeting, we are really hoping that you will be willing to help us make this a successful and special meeting.

We are planning to have this meeting as an in-person event. Please return the following letter of intent indicating what options you wish to include as part of your sponsorship of our event (all costs listed in Canadian Dollars, with approximate conversions to USD and Euros provided). We are planning for between 150 and 300 people. Additionally, since as far as we know the ISCC is not planning to have a meeting in 2023, we have decided to add in a track for contributions of research at the forefront of one-dimensional GC. The draft symposium schedule has two GC×GC courses on Sunday, Monday through Thursday we will have our technical program which includes two award lectures, three plenary lectures, 100 invited and contributed talks, and a collection of poster presentations.
